Food Everywhere Coalition (FEC) is a community-based program; operating under a 501c3 status of It Takes A Tribe (ITAT). Kelvin "The Urban Farmer" Williams formed FEC 10 years ago with 2-specific goals in mind:

- Assist with the accessibility of fresh produce through gardening - urbanizing communities who are in need of food with a collaborative of Urban Farmers
- Subsidize Kelvin "The Urban Farmer" Williams in public school with:
 - Teaching and developing kids healthy eating life styles by growing and cooking fresh produce;
 - Teaching the entrepreneur side of farming; and
 - Teaching how science, math, history, environmental health, and or **ALL SUBJECTS** are a viable part of student's life in the garden.

By partnering with FEC, you will be associated with **Public School Gardens**, and you'll give FEC more opportunities to raise the money needed to fund a sustainable society.

A Public School Garden budget is estimated at \$12,400 per year; this cost includes 2 farmers:

- Working at the school garden twice a week;
- Creating and or maintaining school garden with students;
- Installing an irrigation system
- Performing cooking and demonstration classes for students;
- Setting up and managing student farmer markets;
- All materials like dirt, compost, seeds, plants, compost boxes/bends, tools, storage shed, etc...

There is VERY LITTLE funding available for Public School Gardens because of social-economic stigmas and limitations. We are working to engage in activities that promote healthy eating, active lifestyle, and community engagement.

The goal is to raise funds to off-set and sustain current programs, and accept more school that have requested a garden for the upcoming academic school year. By receiving 294 memberships of a minimum \$25 a month, we will be able to fund one of the Public School Gardens like Betsy Ross Elementary, Booker T. Washington High School, Drew Academy, Jack Yates High School, James Barry Elementary, Kennedy Elementary School, and Wheatley High School; the current Public School Gardens of FEC.

Your yearly membership will include:

- Your name posted at the Public School Garden
- A bi-annual gift box of produce grown at the Public School Garden
- A bi-annual membership visit to the Public School Garden
- Picture and or video footage of the Public School Garden
- Monthly update on the Public School Garden

Food is for everyone, and a FEC membership expresses your commitment to fresh food in our great city, allows us to get back to simple living by working to ensure that food, one of the basic needs, is accessible to **ALL**.
